



OPTIONS FOR COMPANY REGISTRATION IN AUSTRALIA FOR FOREIGN COMPANIES



Companies incorporated overseas but intending to operate in Australia can choose among 4 types of business structures, namely:

- Proprietary Limited (Pty Ltd) Company (Subsidiary)
- Branch Office
- Representative Office
- Shelf Company

| <p>BEST FOR</p> <p>Foreign companies seeking to incorporate a local company with separate liability and legal entity.</p> <p>SETUP REQUIREMENTS</p> <p>Before lodging application with ASIC, the following requirements must be processed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Registered company name • Registered office address • At least 1 resident director (or a nominee director to act on their behalf) • Company secretary • Company constitution (how the company will be governed) <p>REGISTRATION TIMELINE</p> <p>Registering a Pty Ltd can take 4-8 weeks, provided all documents are presented and thoroughly verified. If additional requirements are requested, the process can take longer. Delays in government processing are inevitable.</p> <p>RESTRICTIONS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cannot have more than 50 non-employee shareholders • Cannot engage in any fundraising activity that requires a prospectus | <p>BEST FOR</p> <p>Foreign companies that want to carry out business and manage their operations in Australia without separation of liability and legal entity.</p> <p>SETUP REQUIREMENTS</p> <p>To register a Branch Office, the following requirements must be arranged before lodging application:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Certificate of Incorporation/Registration • Registered office address • Resident agent <p>REGISTRATION TIMELINE</p> <p>The general timeline for registering a Branch Office in Australia is 4-12 weeks. Depending on your circumstances, additional requirements may be requested. Delays in government processing are inevitable.</p> <p>RESTRICTIONS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can only be registered by a company incorporated outside of Australia with good financial standing in its country of residence | <p>BEST FOR</p> <p>Foreign companies that intend to perform non-income generating activities; mainly for establishing presence in Australia by conducting market research and/or promoting products/services.</p> <p>SETUP REQUIREMENTS</p> <p>Similar to the setup requirements of a Branch Office, the following must be arranged:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Certificate of Incorporation/Registration • Registered office address • Resident agent <p>REGISTRATION TIMELINE</p> <p>A Representative Office is not required to register with ASIC, but must register with ATO if it will employ locally. The process can take 3-5 weeks. Delays in government processing are inevitable.</p> <p>RESTRICTIONS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can only be registered by a company incorporated outside of Australia with good financial standing in its country of residence • Cannot derive income from activities conducted in Australia • Cannot offer services to third parties • Cannot apply for tax incentives from the government | <p>BEST FOR</p> <p>Foreign companies seeking to immediately start business in Australia by purchasing a 'ready-made' company from a service provider.</p> <p>SETUP REQUIREMENTS</p> <p>The shelf company is already incorporated so only need to make amendments to the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Registered company name • Registered office address • Company constitution • Share transfer • Corporate officeholders • Others (as applicable) <p>REGISTRATION TIMELINE</p> <p>Not applicable since the shelf company is already registered. Transfer of ownership can be completed immediately after purchase.</p> <p>RESTRICTIONS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Treated by Australian laws as a Pty Ltd so the same restrictions shall apply: • Cannot have more than 50 non-employee shareholders • Cannot engage in any fundraising activity that requires a prospectus |
